

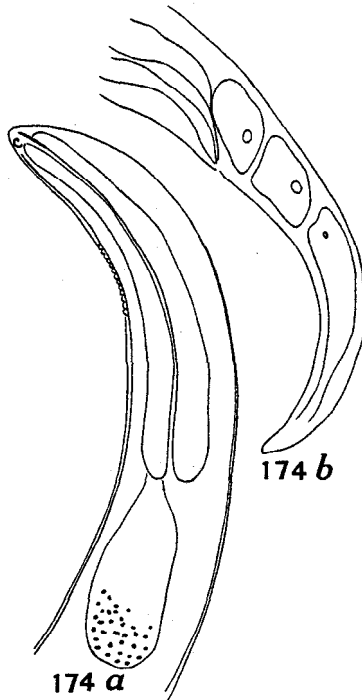
**Camacolaimus falklandiae** n. sp.

Locality and material. — Falkland Islands. St. 15: 1♀

Dimensions: L = 1,198 mm.,  $\alpha = 21,78$ ,  $\beta = 7,305$ ,  $\gamma = 9,81$ , V = 47,08 %

Body about evenly thick and tapering only very little anteriorly and posteriorly up to the anus. Cuticle finely annulated. Head rounded. Cephalic bristles were not found. Dorsal wall of the pharynx in usual manner strongly thickened. Lateral organs situated far anteriorly, small, spiral-shaped, measuring about  $1/3$  of the corresponding head diameter. Oesophagus short and thin, about evenly thick. The large, pyriform, granulated ventral gland situated at the posterior end of the oesophagus, large (length  $49 \mu$ , thickness  $16 \mu$ ). Tail slender, short, in the posterior half about uniformly strongly thinned, with end tip, and containing 3 glands. Thickness of the thinned part about half the anal body diameter. Vulva situated immediately in front of the middle of the body. Female organs paired, with dorsally reflexed ovaries.
