

Camacolaimus longicauda DE MAN

DE MAN 1922, p. 124 and 1922 a, p. 225, fig. 11 a—c

Locality and material. — Falkland Islands, St. 42: 1♀

Dimensions: L = 1,446 mm., $\alpha = 34,43$, $\beta = 4,13$, $\gamma = 12,15$, V = 49,45 %

Besides the old *Camacolaimus tardus* — the type-species of the genus *Camacolaimus* — also another *Camacolaimid* was found in a sample from the above locality. This species seems to show a certain similarity to *C. tardus*, from which it differs only in the tail, being typically elongated, but exceedingly shorter than in the type specimen from the Zuider Sea, measuring $5,4 \times$ the anal body of diameter.
