

Cyartonema germanicum Juario, 1972
(Fig. 215)

Description. Body length 0.8–0.9 mm. Maximum diameter 16–21 μm ($a = 37\text{--}50$). Similar to *C. elegans* (p. 456) except: shorter and stouter (c.f. 'a' values); two pairs of cervical setae absent; oesophageal bulb short and broad, 12 μm long and 17 μm wide; spicules without ventral alae.

Vulva at 50% of body length.

Distribution. Firth of Clyde, West Scotland (intertidal sand).




Fig. 215. *Cyartonema germanicum*. A, Cloacal region; B, Male tail; C, Anterior end of male; D, Cloacal region of another specimen; E, Tail tip. From Juario (1972).
