## Dichromadora arcospiculum new species

Description. Clear body with distinct striation and very faint rods. Broad lateral alae, extending the full length of the body, 4\mu wide or 30\% of the body diameter at the esophageal base, bordered by large dots and crossed by faint bridges. 4 cephalic setae, 2\mu long or 30\% of the head diameter. Cervical setae and ocelli lacking. Amphids faint, oval, above tip of dorsal tooth. Stoma with hollow dorsal tooth and 2 tiny subventral teeth, all weakly-sclerotized. Esophageal bulb single, well-developed, 1/7 of the esophogeal length. Excretory pore not observed. Tail with clear conical tip.

 $Male: 540-578\mu$ ; a, 30-30.4; b, 5.7-6.1; c, 6.3. Spicules 28 $\mu$  long, arcuate, with head turned ventrally. Gubernaculum 18u long, truncate distally, with a lateral shelf just above the tip. No preanal supplements. Tail 5.4-5.7 anal diameters long.

Habitat: Siphonocladus.
