## Metalinhomoeus falklandiae n. sp.


Locality and material. - Falkland Islands, St. 42a: 13

Dimensions:  $L = 2,900 \text{ mm.}, \alpha = 54,72, \beta = 16,86, \gamma = 14,15$ 

Body in its whole length absolutely of even thickness. Cuticle finely annulated. Buccal cavity of usual shape. Head rounded, provided with 4 pairs of submedian bristles, the posterior ones much smaller than the anterior ones. Oesophagus short, slender, provided with a bulb and immediately behind its middle surrounded by the nerve ring. Lateral organs probably circular, with central point. Tail curved, tapering gradually and in its posterior part uniformly very strongly thinned. Spicules short, clumsy, curved. Accessory piece with an apophysis directed dorsally and posteriorly.

St. 42a. Falkland Islands. Port Louis: Greenpatch. Material shaked up from algae and kelp-rhizoids, cast up on shore by storm. 30. 7. 1902.
