

Oncholaimus attenuatus Dujardin, 1845
(Fig. 104)

Description. Body length 2.8 mm. Maximum diameter 60 μm ($a = 47$). Very similar to *O. skawensis* but spicules shorter (1.6 a.b.d.) and stouter and seven pairs of fairly long and slender circumcloacal setae.

Distribution. Falmouth; Clare Island, West Ireland; Whitstable (intertidal sediments).

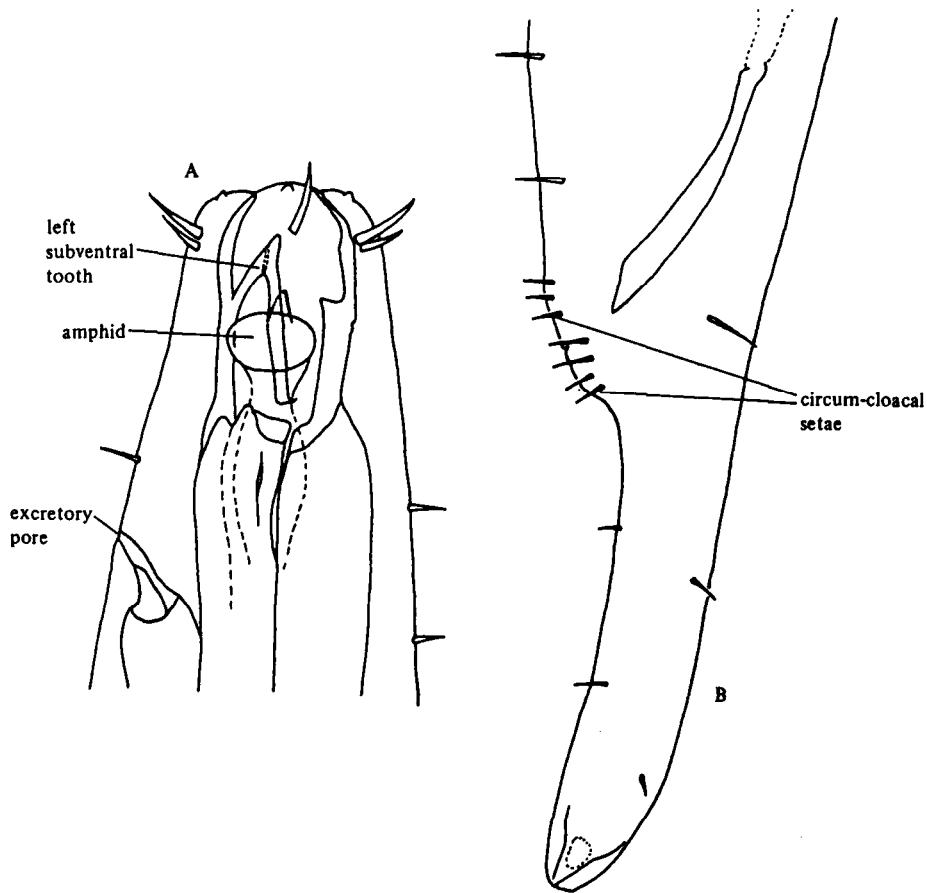


Fig. 104. *Oncholaimus attenuatus*. A, Male head; B, Male tail (from Stekhoven, 1931).
