Paralinhomoeus leptosoma n. sp.

Locality and material. — Falkland Islands, St. 40: 12

Dimensions: $L = 2,100 \text{ mm.}, \quad \alpha = 43,75, \quad \beta = 11,05, \quad \gamma = 18,26$

Body very slender, about evenly thick throughout.

Cuticle smooth. Head truncate, at its front end with submedian, slender bristles. Buccal cavity typical. Oesophagus short, with an ovoid, strongly muscular bulb, 46 μ in length, or about 1/4 of the oesophageal length; its thickness 26 μ . Tail about cylindrical, posteriorly rounded. Position of vulva not stated. Female organs paired, with straight gonads and not reflexed ovaries.
