

Pseudosteineria subg.n.

8 groups of exceedingly long cervical setae about on level with amphids. Other cervical and somatic setae relatively short.

Type: *T. (P.) anteferens*

A. Amphids more than 1 head diameter behind anterior end. Cervical setae between amphids and anterior end. Longest cervical setae 57 μ :

T. horridus (STEINER 1916a) = *Monhystera h*

B. Amphids less than 1 head diameter behind anterior end. Cervical setae on level with, or slightly posterior to, amphids. Longest cervical setae 70—90 μ .

1. Tail in adults 4—5 anal diameters long. Spicula 60—72 μ long, large; gubernaculum with apophysis:

T. anticipans n.sp.

2. Tail in adults 6—7,5 anal diameters long. Spicula 32 μ long, narrow; gubernaculum without apophysis:

T. anteferens n.sp.
