

Rhabdodemania imer Warwick and Platt, 1973
(Fig. 132)

Description. Body length 3.0 mm. Maximum diameter 24 μm ($a = 123$). Cuticle smooth. Four 4 μm cephalic setae situated anterior to six 16.5 μm (1.3 h.d.) cephalic setae. Amphids and excretory pore not seen. Buccal cavity conical, teeth absent. Nerve ring 0.46 times oesophagus length from anterior. Tail cylindrical, 5.8 a.b.d.

Spicules 26 μm (1.1 a.b.d.) long.

Gubernaculum 14 μm . 6 minute supplements extending 147 μm anterior to cloaca.

Female not described.

Distribution. Loch Ewe, Scotland (intertidal sand).




Fig. 132. *Rhabdodemania imer*. A, Male head; B, Posterior end of male; C, Spicules and gubernaculum. Original.
