Theristus brachysetosus n. sp.

Locality and material. — Graham Land, St. 6: 200, 1 juv.

Dimensions: L=2,504 mm., a=20,87, $\beta=6,26$, $\gamma=12,27$, V=64,06 % Body rather evenly thick and tapering only gradually towards both extremities. Cuticle annulated. Head truncate, provided with short, slender, submedian bristles. Buccal cavity about 2×10^{-5} broader than deep, bordered by straight walls, in its foremost part bladdered. Oesophagus short and thick. Tail in the 2 anterior thirds conical, in the posterior third uniformly strongly thinned, with some slender end hairs.

St. 6. Graham Region. 64° 36′ S. — 57° 42′ W. Stones and gravel. Mud-sample. 125 m. 20. 1. 1902. Number of species found: 29; Number of specimens found: 40.
