

***Theristus brachysetosus* n. sp.**

Locality and material. — Graham Land, St. 6: 2♀♀, 1 juv.

Dimensions: L = 2,504 mm.,  $a = 20,87$ ,  $\beta = 6,26$ ,  $\gamma = 12,27$ , V = 64,06 %

Body rather evenly thick and tapering only gradually towards both extremities. Cuticle annulated. *Head truncate, provided with short, slender, submedian bristles.* Buccal cavity about 2 × broader than deep, bordered by straight walls, in its foremost part bladdered. Oesophagus short and thick. Tail in the 2 anterior thirds conical, in the posterior third uniformly strongly thinned, with some slender end hairs.

St. 6. Graham Region. 64° 36' S. — 57° 42' W. Stones and gravel. Mud-sample. 125 m. 20. 1. 1902.
