

*Viscosia langrunensis* (De Man, 1890)  
(Fig. 111)

*Description.* Body length 2.6 mm. Maximum diameter 26  $\mu\text{m}$  ( $a = 100$ ). Cephalic setae 3.5–4  $\mu\text{m}$  (0.2 h.d.). Amphids 7  $\mu\text{m}$  wide (0.37 times c.d.). Dorsal tooth and smaller subventral tooth extend anterior to middle of buccal cavity, both single tipped. Tail conico-cylindrical with slightly distended tip, 6.6 a.b.d.

Spicules 22  $\mu\text{m}$  (1.3 a.b.d.).

*Distribution.* Northern Ireland (intertidal sand).




Fig. 111. *Viscosia langrunensis*. A, Male head; B, Male tail; C, Cloacal region.
