Ἄνοπλος, unarmed and σῶμα, body.

Body without armature of any sort; caudal rami slender, linear. First antennae slender, the terminal part 2-jointed, slightly hinged in δ . Exopod of 2nd. antennae rudimentary. Mandible palp slender, 2-jointed. Both rami of 1st. legs 1-jointed; 3 following pairs very slender, 2nd. basal joint forming with first an elbow joint; endopod very small, 1-jointed.
