'Apktos = northern and Pontius.

Anterior division of body greatly expanded,  
the head very large and projecting at the pos-  
tero-lateral corners; lappets of 3 following  
segs. well developed. First antennae short,  
8-jointed in ♀, posterior pair very small.  
Maxillae with unequal lobes, both pairs of  
mxpds. stout. Exopod of 4th. legs 3-jointed,  
endopod 2-jointed, last legs rudimentary.
