♀ carapace spherical - Thorax 2 & 3 with side projections - Gen. seg't. much wider than foll. seg't. equally wide throughout - with a process on either side. 10 Aut. 9-joints - 2° 4-joints. Tube of siphone narrower than basal part, reaching at least behind 2 msp'ds. 132 & Lⁱ 5 of 10 mx. broad at base, narrowed at end - 82° mx and mspd. very stout. 4° legs wanting - 10 to 30 legs with 3-jointed rami 1 on 1° leg Rⁱ 3 with 3 marginal spines + 5 plumose setae, Rⁱ 2 with 1 plumose seta - On 3° legs Rⁱ 3 with 5 plumose setae; Rⁱ 2 of 10 to 3° legs with double teeth on the outer margin - Apical 5ⁱ of Rⁱ 3 of 2° legs awl-shaped - Egg mass spherical, about 20 eggs.










