Brada, an annelid genus and φίλος.

Body made up of two parts; posterior part rounded and carrying two dorsal (not terminal) egg sacks like *Herpyllobius*, anterior part produced into a petiole, the anterior chitin margin a little reflexed. Under the chitin margin and fused with it are many rudiments which show that *Bradophilus* has a form similar to *Herpyllobius*, and a body made up of two dissimilar parts joined by a petiole
