Cancer, a crab and incola, inhabitant

Body 10 seg^s/5, cylindrical, diminishing slightly
from in front backwards - 5° and 6° seg^s/5. more
distinctly separated than in Canthocamptus.
10 anten, short, thickset, 8-jointed, strongly
hinged in male - 2° anten, short, outer ramus
1-jointed - mand, palp also 1-jointed, 1° max.
with distinct endo + exopods, the latter armed
with claw-like spine - 2° max, with only one
digitiform lobe inside the claw-bearing joint.
mxps, normally developed - 1° swim. legs with
2-jointed endopod, much longer than exopod
other legs with exopod longer than endopod.
both rami 3-jointed - only one ovisack.
