

¹² Anchorabulidae - Harpacticoida

Syn. Ceratonotus Sars, 1909. p. 316

Body armed with a double series of peculiar dorsal processes, lateral and subdorsal processes wanting. no rostrum. First antennae slender, 4-jointed, first joint the largest. Both rami of first legs 2-jointed, subequal. Endopod of 4 succeeding pairs 1-jointed. Last pair simple, 2-jointed.
