Body ovate, the cephalic segt. forming  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the entire length. Abdomen 3-jointed. Endopod of 2nd. antennae 2-jointed. Mandible stylet shaped, palp 1-jointed. Maxilla and mxpds. as in *Asterocheres*. Both rami of first 3 pairs of legs 3-jointed; fourth pair with but a single ramus, 1-jointed.
