Syn. Cyclopinella Sars, 1913, p. 16.

A diminutive of Cyclops.

General appearance like Cyclopina; head separated from 1st. thorax segt. by a distinct suture. First antennae short, 12-jointed; 2nd. pair with 1st. joint slender and smooth. Mandible palp without an exopod. Palp of maxillae with the 2 outer appendages well developed and equal. Last legs less rudimentary than usual, being distinctly 3-jointed.
