

Peltidiidae - Harpacticoida.

Eupeltidium valid

E. glabrum (M)

Syn. Eupeltidium A. Scott, 1909, p. 206.

Body short and depressed: no trace of the anastomosing chitine bands found in *Peltidium*: no dorsal projections. First antennae 6-segd: endopod of 2nd antennae 3-segd, exopod short and 2-segd. Mandibular palp uniramous. 2nd maxillae and uropods similar to those of *Alteutha* and *Peltidium*. First endopod 2-segd, considerably broadened, exopod prehensile, tipped with stout claws and 3-segd. Basal expansion of 5th legs nearly obsolete. distal segt elongate with stout setae. First antennae in male prehensile: abdomen 4-segd: 5th legs reduced in size -
