POECILOSTOMATA TOIDA

ἵππος = horse and μόλγος = hide.

Body not very cyclopoid in shape; anterior division only slightly dilated.<sup>56</sup> Caudal rami much produced. First antennae short, 6-jointed; posterior pair feeble. Mxpds. not fully developed. Swimming legs coarsely made, 1st. pair not modified, last pair 1-jointed.
