Lichomolgidae - Cyclopoidea  
POECILOSTOMATIDA

G. O. Sars, 1918

L. pusilla <sup>(M)</sup>.

Syn. Lichomolgella Sars, 1918, p. 216.

A diminutive of Lichomolgus.

General form resembling *Machrocheiron*, but tail shorter and stouter; 2 peculiar ventral lappets on gen. segt. in ♀. First antennae very short but having the full number of joints. Second antennae distinctly prehensile. Endopod of 4th. legs very short and 1-jointed, last legs also 1-jointed, the other rami 3-jointed.
