Lichomolgidae - ~~Cytopoidea~~

Linckiomolgas, valid.

Poecilostomatoida

Stebbing, 1900.

L. caeruleus (M)

Syn. Linckiomolgas Stebbing, 1900, b, p. 664.

Linckia and μολγός = hide or skin

Body pyriform, made up of 10 seg'ts. Carapace  
(head + 1<sup>st</sup> seg't) long + broad: 2<sup>nd</sup> + 3<sup>rd</sup> seg'ts broad  
but short: 4<sup>th</sup> seg't and 5<sup>th</sup>, abruptly narrower.  
Gen. seg't broader than long in ♀. Abdomen  
with 4 very small seg'ts: anal laminae as wide  
as long. No eyes visible. First antennae 8-  
jointed, with setae: second pair 4-jointed, ter-  
minating in a hook.  
First 4 pairs of feet biramous, rami 3-jointed,  
except the 4<sup>th</sup> endopod, which is 2-jointed  
5<sup>th</sup> feet rudimentary, 1-jointed.
