1° antennae 6-jointed : 2° pair 4-jointed
Endopod of 4° foot much shorter than the
exopod, and the same size and form as the
 5° foot, with 2 setae on the end; 1° mxpd.

like a cock's comb: 2° mxpds. not of equal size
 3° joint of exopod of 3° and 4° legs has 3 exter-
nal and one terminal spine, all toothed.

Endopod of 4° 2-jointed : 5° legs 1-jointed.

Abdomen 5-jointed: genital segt. with rudimen-
tary 6-legs on lateral margins.
