

Pediculus = synonym.

Baird says "The first notice of any species of Lernaepoda was by Gissler in 1751, who, in the twelfth volume of the Acta Suecica, describes & figures a species of Lerneia found by him on the salmon, and which he called "Pediculus salmonis" or Lax-lusen." There is no 12th volume of the Acta Suecica, but in vol. 12, 1751 of Kongl. Svensk. Vetenskaps Academiens Handlingar, p. 185, Nils

Gissler described "Lax-lusen" but did not mention the name *Pediculus*. Hence the name has no scientific authority and must be dropped, especially as it was afterward used by Linnaeus for a genus of Epizoa.
