Head small, triangular, with a pair of double antennae, short, cylindrical, the rami unequal and divergent, 2- or 3-jointed. Body elongate, cylindrical, enlarging from the head backwards.
5 thorax seg'ts., the first 4 of equal size, the 5th. as large as all the others. Abdomen narrow and short, 3-jointed. Two first pairs of legs long and slender, 3-jointed; 4 other pairs terminated by a pointed claw; legs retractile into a cupule at their base.
