Body short and stout, subcylindric; caudal rami short and thick. First antennae 5-jointed strongly hinged in ♂. Exopod of 2nd. antennae 2-jointed; mandible palp also 2-jointed. Endopod of 1st. legs 2-jointed, of succeeding pairs 1-jointed. Last legs with distal and proximal joints fused, uniramous, 10 setae.
