Named from its false similarity to
Eucanthus.

Characterized by the form - post! mx pds.
which, as in Eucanthus, present a large falciform
claw but it is alongside - mouth-tube and
not behind it. In Eucanthus - exopod
4th pair of legs is elongated into - shape of
a hook or claw, while here it is flattened
and does not differ from that - 3 preceding
pairs. It is related not to Bomolochus
but to Eucanthus.
