Pseudo and ψύλλος, a glea.

Somewhat like *Clausia*; abdomen not distinct from thorax. 1st. antennae 6-jointed, short. 2nd. antennae like those of *Hersiliodes*. 2nd. maxpds. 2-jointed, with extremely long and powerful terminal claws. Other mouth parts unknown. Rami of first 4 pairs of legs 3-jointed. 5th. legs short, composed of a single lamelliform joint. Male unknown.

5-jointed - uniramous-tipped with curved setae
