POSSIBLE SYNONYM.

Body elongate, depressed; cephalothorax with two pairs of antennae, free mandibles and 2 pairs of mx'pds. 1st. antennae 6-jointed, second pair elongate, 3-jointed. 1st. mx'pds. 2-jointed, stout; 2nd. pair 4-jointed, last joint acute. Abdomen with 5 segts., the 1st. fused with cephalothorax. All abdomen segts armed with swimming legs, 5th. pair uniramous, 2-jointed, the others biramous, 3-jointed. Postabdomen 4-jointed, anal laminae with long setae.
