anterior body spherical: segts without lateral projections. Abdomen with 2 segts between Gen. segt. and furca. 1st Ant! 19-jointed. Re of 2nd Ant! elongate, $\frac{3}{4}$ as long as Ri 1. Siphon egg-shaped, without tube, with wide opening - Mds. not toothed; palps short, sharp with short spines. 1st mx. with 3-4 spines. Swimming legs, Re 3 with only 2 external spines & with 4, 4, 4, 4 plumose setae; Ri 3 with 6, 6, 5, 3 spines: end joint of 5th legs with 3 spines. Lateral coeca of intestine large. Egg-balls ellipsoidal, containing 5-6 eggs.
