S. bilobus ^①.

Syn. Selius, Krøyer, 1837, p. 479.

Selius = A parasite in Martial, II, 12.

Female Cephalothorax of small size: antennae two, filiform, 6-jointed. 3 pairs of legs 1st and 3rd. 5-jointed, 2nd 2-jointed - all 3 with setae, 2nd pair subcheliform?

Two laminae at the sides of the anus. Egg-sacks longer than the body, conical, wide - bilobed near the base - Eggs multi-seriate -

Length of Aphrodite (host) 26 mm. Length of Selisia 5.66 mm. ; of egg-sacks 3.25 mm. of body of parasite 2.41 mm.
