Nordmann proposed this name
for van Beneden's Lernanthropus p.
but it has not been accepted.

Stalagmus = the name of a slave in Plautus.
Σταλαχμός. = dripping (of blood).

Male. Cephalothorax ovate, sides angular; abdomen narrower, elongate; anterior part of thorax indistinctly 3-jointed, post. part ovate. 3rd. & 4th. pairs of swimming legs bipartite; rami very long & equal - 2 eyes.

Female, cephalothorax widely ovate, sides set with acetabula; ventral shield deeply emarginate, 3rd. pair of legs bipartite, endopod very short & 2-jointed, exopod long, 1-jointed; 4th. pair with equal rami, abdomen 2-jointed, covered by v. dorsal shields.
