

Caligoida

Caligidae.

Stasiotes, synonym.

Wright, 1876

S. rhinodontes

The same name was used by Jan for a snake genus in 1862. In its place is suggested Prosaetes, g.v.

ΣΤΑΣΙΩΤΗΣ = one who stirs up sedition, a partisan.

Carapace as wide as long, frontal plates, con-
spicuous. - First thorax seg't fused with head -
2nd, 3rd, & 4th, free - 2nd, & 3rd, without dorsal
plates, 4th, with a feebly developed pair,
Gen. seg't obtusely truncated & notched post.
Abdomen narrow, completely covered by gen. seg't.
First antennae 2-jointed; 2nd pair stout, 4-jointed.
Rostrum long & narrow; md. curved & toothed on
inside; mx. indistinctly 2-jointed; Maxilla broad
and large. Thorax feet all biramous, first 3
pairs with 2-jointed rami, armed with plumose
setae - 4th, pair with 1-jointed rami without
plumose setae.
