Carapace rounded, shield-shaped. Frontal plates with lamules = fourth segment free, without plates, = genital segment also without plates but prolonged backward on either side of the abdomen as two elongate, blunt processes almost as long as the abdomen itself.

The latter is long, 2-jointed, and terminates in 2 small anal laminae with short setae. First and fourth swimming legs uniramous second & third biramous.
