Lernaeopodidae.
Lernaeopodoida
T. ziegleri

A synonym of Brachiella thynni.
(Wilson, 1915, p. 603).

Head enlarged + well separated from v neck.
bearing 2 pairs of antennae, a pair of mx, and a
pair of maxils. Neck long, stout, cylindrical -
Organs of attachment (2nd maxils) at v junction neck
+ body = entirely separate, each with its own attach-
ment disk. Body triangular, divided by long grooves
on both dorsal + ventral surface into 3 regions - one
central + two lateral: imperfectly segmented by
transverse grooves. Two pairs of post processes, v
ventral pair about as long as v body - v dorsal pair
nearly twice as long - Egg-sacs narrow cylindrical
tapering toward v ends - longer than v dorsal processes.
No trace of legs or eyes.
