

ABOUT THE COVER

Ophionereis schlayeri with *Melita* n.sp., illustrated by Sharne Wiedland, a freelance artist whose illustrations appear in many scientific and popular Australian articles. *Ophionereis schlayeri* is a common ophiuroid in Port Jackson, Australia which lives under stones just below low water. The undescribed species of *Melita* is an obligate commensal living along the ambulacral grooves of the host.

PROFILE OF THE CRUSTACEAN SECTION, AUSTRALIAN MUSEUM

Jim Lowry works on lysianassoid and cerapid amphipod systematics. His current projects are: development of a family structure for the lysianassoid amphipods; redescription of type species of world lysianassoid genera; description of Australasian lysianassoid fauna, all with Helen Stoddart; and description of Australasian cerapid fauna with Penny Berents.

George (Buz) Wilson has recently joined the crustacean section from Scripps Institute of Oceanography. Buz works on isopods. His projects include research on deep sea asellotes, crustacean phylogeny and isopod sex organs. He is planning a project on phreatoicidean isopods, which are found in freshwater streams, pools, and ground waters of southern Australia and Tasmania.

Des Griffin is the longest serving member of the Crustacean Section and a world expert on majid crabs. As director of the museum he no longer has much time for research, but he is currently working with Helen Stoddart on the deep sea lobsters of eastern Australia.

Helen Stoddart is currently working on lysianassoid amphipods with Jim Lowry and deep sea lobsters with Des Griffin. She is also working on a synonymical catalogue of the world species of lysianassoid amphipods.

Roger Springthorpe is the technical officer and a specialist on the local crustacean fauna. He is involved in collection management, field work, survey work and he makes the plates for Helen and Jim's lysianassoid work. Roger and Jim are currently putting the final touches on a catalogue of the malacostracan type collection, which of course includes all the amphipod types.

Steve Keable is a research assistant whose main job has been the illustration of the type species for the world lysianassoid genera project. He is also a graduate student in the section whose thesis work is on habitat partitioning in tropical crustacean scavengers.

Penny Berents is the collection manager for the Invertebrate Division. She is also working on amphipod life history studies, and she and Jim are slowly but surely describing the Australian cerapid fauna.

Amphipod holdings in the Australian Museum are strong in general amphipod collections from the Australasian area. Major collections come from the New Zealand and Australian subantarctic islands, the Western Australian coast and the North West shelf, the Great Barrier Reef and the New South Wales coast. At the Museum of Victoria, Melbourne, Gary Poore has extensive collections from the bays of Victoria, the Bass Strait and the continental slope off south-eastern Australia. All of these collections are available for study to any qualified workers.

OTHER AUSTRALIAN AMPHIPOD PROJECTS

Jean Just has a change of title and address: Associate Director, Fauna, Australian Biological Resources Study, GPO Box 1383, Canberra, ACT 2601, Australia. He has less time for research these days but is steadily continuing his studies of the diverse Australasian siphonocitines and the fascinating slope fauna of south-eastern Australia.

Bill Williams, Adelaide University, and **Jerry Barnard**, Smithsonian Institution, have finished the second part of their series on Australian freshwater amphipods. This part describes new taxa from Western Australia, South Australia, New South Wales and Queensland. The third part, still in the planning stage, will describe the diverse Tasmanian fauna. The first part which redescribed all known Australian freshwater amphipods (Records of the Australian Museum, Supplement 10) is available from the Assistant Editor, Records of the Australian Museum, PO Box A285, Sydney South, NSW 2000, Australia for \$54.00 (plus \$2.50 postage within Australia and to New Zealand, or \$6.00 postage airmail to other countries).

Wolfgang Zeidler, South Australian Museum, has finished a large paper on the deep water hyperiideans off the New South Wales coast and is currently working on large collections from New South Wales south to Tasmania. This work will contain keys to all Australian species and a new key to families of the world. Wolfgang says that when this work is finished more than half of the world hyperiidean species will be reported from eastern Australia. He is also working on the mound spring amphipods from the arid zone of central Australia. These intriguing chiltonines are almost identical morphologically but electrophoretic data is telling a different story.

TROPICAL AMPHIPOD PROJECT

For the last three years Jerry Barnard, Smithsonian Institution, Jim Lowry, Australian Museum, Alan Myers, Cork College, Ireland and Jim Thomas, Reef Foundation, Florida Keys have met at the Christensen Research Institute near Madang in northern Papua New Guinea to collect and describe the gammaridean amphipod fauna of the Madang

Lagoon. The project was the brainchild of Thomas and is being supported in part by the Christensen Foundation.

The area is a complex lagoon system with a submerged outer barrier reef plus fringing reefs, patch reefs, large areas of rubble at the back of the reefs, and sand, sandy mud and mud bottoms. In the upper reaches there are small freshwater streams and small areas of mangroves.

To date about 200 amphipod species have been collected and identified. These taxa have been divided into groups for each taxonomist to study and describe. The results of these studies will be published as a series of papers on the Amphipoda of the Madang Lagoon. The results will be published as a series of papers in the Records of the Australian Museum. If anyone is interested in more information on this project they should contact Jim Thomas.

Because of the key position of the New Guinea microplate between the Pacific and Indian-Australian plates, the results of this work should, in addition to documenting the amphipod fauna, provide new insights on the distribution patterns of Indo-Pacific amphipods.

**NEW AND REVISED AMPHIPOD TAXA IN AMPHIPOD NEWSLETTER 11 - 18.
AN INDEX TO THE BIBLIOGRAPHY.**

This index has had a very long and intricate gestation period, and was originally prepared in three parts. The first two were prepared with the assistance of George Crawford and Jan Vader. The three parts were expertly blended by Jim Lowry and typeset by Jenny Gates in Sydney.

This index uses the model established by Crawford & Vader for the index to AN 1 to 10 (see AN 11 and 14), with separate lists of family, genus- and species-level new taxa, all in alphabetical order. The references are to the bibliographies in AN and give issue and page number (AN 13 unfortunately came out unpaginated); those who do not have these issues available can order copies from Wim Vader for 5 US dollars per issue.

The systematic index of new species, arranged systematically, in AN 11 to 17 will not become ready in time for AN 18 and will be printed in AN 19. If enough subscribers express interest, I can also prepare a list of monographic treatments (including keys) of amphipod families and genera in AN 11 to 17. This is a big job, and I need to know beforehand that it is worthwhile and will be used.

In the future, I plan to give an index of new and revised amphipod taxa for each AN in the next issue. The best would of course be to have it in the current issue, but that will require editing and production of AN at the same address, something we have not yet achieved.

Please let me know whether this type of index is still helpful, or if in the PC-age everybody can easily collect this information on her or his own.
