


Fig. 123. Bathylaimus inermis. A, Juvenile head; B, Juvenile tail. Original.

Bathylaimus inermis (Ditlevsen, 1918) (Fig. 123)

Description. Body length 2.7-3.8 mm (a = 23-42). Cuticle smooth. Labial setae two-jointed, 0.2 h.d. long. Longer cephalic setae four-jointed, 0.64 h.d.; shorter setae two-jointed, 0.27 h.d. Amphids subspiral, 0.23 times c.d. in diameter, situated at base of buccal cavity. Tail 3 a.b.d. long with a distinctly swollen tip in both sexes.

Spicules and gubernaculum similar to preceding species.

Distribution. Exe estuary (intertidal sand or low water mark).
