


Fig. 181. Calmicrolaimus honestus. A, Male tail; B, Male head; C, Female tail. Original.

Calomicrolaimus honestus (De Man, 1922) (Fig. 181)

Description. Body-length 1.3–1.4. Maximum diameter 32–41 μ m (a = 32–42). Six short 1.5 μ m and four longer 6–7 μ m (0.6–0.7 h.d.) cephalic setae. Few scattered caudal setae, particularly in the male, but somatic setae otherwise absent. Amphids 7–8 μ m (0.4–0.5 c.d.) wide, 1.5–1.6 h.d. posterior. Buccal cavity fairly well-cuticularised with dorsal and subventral teeth about equal in size. Posterior oesophageal bulb 27 × 18 μ m, without a markedly cuticularised lining. Tail 3.4–3.9 a.b.d.

Spicules 30-34 μ m (1.1-1.4 a.b.d.) measured as a curve, arcuate with a rounded proximal cephalisation. Gubernaculum 19-22 μ m (0.7-0.8 times spicule length), proximally curved and lying free from spicules. Six or seven fine pore-like precloacal supplements.

Vulva at 44-49% of body length.

Distribution. Northumberland coast, North East England (sublittoral fine sand); Exe estuary, South West England; Loch Ewe, West Scotland (intertidal sand); Tamar estuary, South West England (intertidal mud).
