Camacolaimus longicauda DE MAN

DE MAN 1922, p. 124 and 1922 a, p. 225, fig. 11 a-c

Locality and material. — Falkland Islands, St. 42: 19

Dimensions: L = 1,446 mm., $\alpha = 34,43$, $\beta = 4,13$, $\gamma = 12,15$, V = 49,45 %Besides the old Camacolaimus tardus — the type-species of the genus Camacolaimus — also another Camacolaimid was found in a sample from the above locality. This species seems to show a certain similarity to C. tardus, from which it differs only in the tail, being typically elongated, but exceedingly shorter than in the type specimen from the Zuider Sea, measuring $5.4 \times$ the anal body of diameter.
