Carapace large. oval. Frontal plates well defined - First 3 thorax segts joined with the head - fourth segt free and armed with small dorsal plates - Gen. segt broad and usually prolonged backward in a lobe on either side "abdomen" - These lobes often dentate at ends and on the outer margins. Abdomen 2-jointed & first joint usually with lateral processes. Anal laminae with long setae all the legs biramous; the exopods of the first 3 pairs with minute conaceous processes - Rami of 1st pair 2-jointed, of 2nd + 3rd pairs 3-jointed - 4th pair rudimentary, hidden, only basal joint. no rami
