The fact that Krøyer changed this name
to Blias is good proof that his genus
Aethon proved untenable

Blias = name of a lascivious woman in Ovid

Head rounded, separated by a constriction
from smooth, thick, oval body, which is
unsegmented and without processes -

Abdomen 2-jointed, small, with two short
terminal setae. Anterior antennae short &

thick; posterior pair 2-jointed, unciniate.

Mouth at posterior part of head -

Two pairs of uniramiose articulate thorax
appendages.

Male a pigmy like that of Chondracanthus.
