Brada, an annelid genus and filos.

Body made up of two parts; posterior part rounded and carrying two dorsal (not terminal) egg sacks like *Herpylllobius*, anterior part produced into a petiole, the anterior chitin margin a little reflexed. Under the chitin margin and fused with it are many rudiments which show that *Bradysphilus* has a form similar to *Herpylllobius*, and a body made up of two dissimilar parts joined by a petiole
