

Lernaeidae — Caligoida

Dysphorus valid

Head and neck distinct, with paired clusters of branched horns for attachment: rest of body fused into a cylindrical trunk, not segd: trunk straight, legs widely separated on head and neck: egg cases long and cylindrical, eggs multiseriate.
