E. clausii^(M).Syn. Eunicicola Kurz, 1877, p.Eurygnotus T. Scott,Eunicicola G.O. Sars, 1918, p. 204,Eunice, an annelid genus and cola, inhabiting

Body short and stout, the 2 divisions sharply separated, the anterior one pear-shaped. Tail in ♀ 4-, in ♂ 5-jointed. First antennae slender; second pair stout, 3-jointed, last joint with 2 claw-like appendages ending in a cup-shaped dilatation. A large circular disk in front of the mouth in ♀., none in ♂. Posterior mxdps. in ♀ transv. processes covered with spines in ♂ strong and clawed. Only 3 pairs of legs. first 2 biramose, 3rd. with exopod only.
