Head oval, distinct, thick set, obtuse. Four well-marked quadrilateral thorax seg'ts, about equaling head in size : Gen. seg't short. Abdomen small, conical, articulate, with 2 small anal lamellae. Anterior antennae setaceous, many-jointed, basal joint enlarged : post. pair small, mucinate. Second mxpds. large, with single end claw. All the thoracic legs are biramous, & rami short and 2-jointed. First mxpds also projecting beyond margin carapace.
