Body subcylindric, no demarkation between anterior and posterior parts, all seg'ts closely crowded together. Caudal rami moderate. First antennae short thick, hirsute; exopod of second pair 3-jointed. Endopod of first legs 2-jointed. Distal and proximal joints in last legs fused.
