General form like *Augaptitus*, but abdomen 4-jointed; rostral appendages styliform, like *Heterorhabdus*. 1st. ant. longer than body; 2nd. ant. with elongated equal rami; mandibles with masticatory blade slender, almost styliform, toothed at the end, palp biramous; maxillae with well-defined endopod lobe, 2 submaxillary setiferous lobes, no epipodal lobe.

Rami of first 4 pairs of legs 3-jointed; 5th. pair like others 3-jointed.
