

Camacolaimus cylindricauda n. sp.

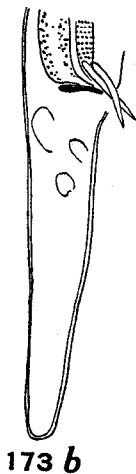

Locality and material. — Falkland Isl. St. 42: 1♀; South Georgia. St. 22e: 1♂

Dimensions: $L = 1,174$ mm., $a = 35,58$, $\beta = 9,152$, $\gamma = 12,10$

Body slender, from the middle of the oesophageal region up to the anus of absolutely even thickness and tapering only gradually in the anterior half of the oesophageal region.

Cuticle smooth. Head rounded, with short, slender, submedian bristles. Dorsal wall of the foremost part of the pharynx weakly thickened. Oesophagus short, thin, posteriorly weakly bulb-like swollen. Tail on the whole cylindro-conical, at the end evidently rounded. From the anus there protrude some chitinized strongly pointed needle-like organs, perhaps representing the spicules.
